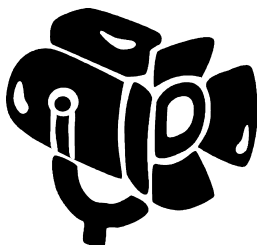
John Frye, Superintendent of Milford Exempted Village Schools presented the 5 year proposal for the schools.
