Robin Noll has opened Day Heights Pharmacy at 5656 Wolfpen Pl. Hill Rd. Stop in and welcome them.



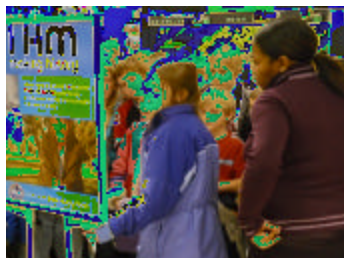
## Around the City
