There will be an opening on the Milford Miami Township Board of Directors this year.

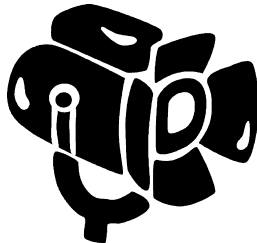
