The Clermont County Long Term Recovery Committee (LTRC) has been working with individuals and families affected by the July 6, 2022 tornados. The LTRC is comprised of faith-based, non-profit and community partners that are focused on the mission of helping residents recover from and restore their lives after a disaster in a timely manner. We currently have 70 clients and growing. Over the last 2 months, the LTRC has allocated all of the donations that were amassed following the event. We are reaching out to local business partners to request additional financial donations to continue providing assistance to residents affected by the July 6, 2022 tornadoes.

Donations will be used to provide clients with financial support to recover including: home repairs, temporary and long term housing, debris clearing, insurance deductibles, and other tornado related needs. 100% of the donations go to impacted residents of Clermont County.
